Core Values

 execution of our activities and service.

Responsibilities and Activities

- **Spiritual Growth:** As a ministry team area in SVPC, we are committed to take our walk with God seriously and seek to use our faith to inform, infuse and inspire all that we do.
- **Evangelism:** We commit to incorporating evangelism into our work and play. For us, this means that we share our faith, share a story of how God has transformed our lives, and invite people to learn more about growing

- their faith through the various paths in our church (worship, service, small groups, etc.)
- Collaboration with other ministry teams: We commit also to work with other ministry teams whenever possible.
- Volunteer Engagement: We commit to invite and engage volunteers in the activities and events that are involved in welcoming people to our campus. It is our sincerest desire to make the experience a joyful one and to treat volunteers with love and warmth.

Recurring Activities and Events

The members of the Welcome & Hospitality Ministry Team strive to provide a warm, inviting presence to all those who come onto our campus. We also want to help the SVPC family regularly stay acquainted with each other through logistical support for other church-wide meals and events.

Specific activities in Welcome & Hospitality include

A. Provide a warm, welcoming presence for visitors at each service, before and afterward.

- 1. Recruiting members of the congregation to actively greet those coming to church.
- Provide beverages and snacks as needed and arrange the staffing of the coffee half hour after 10 am service as well as clean up time after serving the coffee.
- 3. Staffing a "Welcome Booth" with trained volunteers on Sundays and at other events throughout the year.
- 4. Name Tags: provide and maintain the Name Tag Cart and temporary nametags. Provide pronoun pins so that all feel seen and honored no matter how they identify.
- B. Providing a large, simple meal in a welcoming atmosphere, as invited, for congregation-wide events. Encouraging congregants to meet new people or become reacquainted.
 - 1. All Church gathering during Advent
 - 2. All Church Picnic in October.
 - 3. Fund community dinners after the Intersections service.
 - 4. Fund occasional brunches after the Early Light service.
 - 5. All-Church special events i.e. Welcome or goodbye to key staff, major

church anniversaries

E. Partnering with other ministry areas or staff, as invited, to assist with welcome & hospitality for large events.

- 1. Bonfire/Hot Cocoa after Christmas Eve early services
- 2. VBS, Day 1 or through Day 4
- 3. PELC first days, two days in September, Monday and Tuesday mornings
- 4. Trunk or Treat, Saturday evening before Halloween, partner with Children's Ministry.
- 5. Easter Egg Hunt partner with Children's Ministry.
- 6. Fund Choir Concert Receptions and possibly provide a Welcome Table, 2X/year
- 7. Help Mission Ministry provide hospitality volunteers for Food Packing events,
